DRAWSTRING BAG

This pretty pouch can be filled with toiletries, making it an ideal gift, or it could be useful storage for lingerie and nightwear. Add a personal touch with appliquéd initials or try quilting the fabric to create a luxurious feel

Make up the bag in mesh fabric without a lining, using the French-seam technique to make a perfect storage pouch for bathroom items!

you will need


- 61 x 43cm (24 x 17in) outer fabric
- 61 x 53.5cm (24 x 21in) fabric for lining
- 61 x 43cm (24 x 17in) fusible fleece
- 122cm (48in) of 1cm (½in) wide ribbon
- Bodkin or safety pin

Finished size 18 x 24 x 5cm (7 x 9½ x 2in)

Using your template

You will need to use the whole tote outline with small cut-out corners from TEMPLATE 1. You will not need to place the template on the fold of the fabric this time.

1 This time we're not going to use the template on the fold of fabric, so place it on a single layer of fabric and draw around the tote outline. Draw the small cut-out corner, then flip the template over and draw the small cut-out corner on the opposite bottom side.

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
